RULES GOVERNING PLAY

USGA Rules prevail except when modified by local rules.

Embedded ball rule (16.3) is in effect when in General Area.

Lift, Clean, and Drop (Rule 14.1)

Out of Bounds (Rule 2.1) is defined by white stakes/Property line on left side of Hole 6 and Hole 7, the road on hole 9 and fence on holes 10-15. Players may proceed under (Rule 18) or use Model Local Rule (E5) 2 stroke penalty.

Red stakes and/or lines define Penalty Areas (Rule 17) on holes 4-8, 10-12, 15 & 16.

No Play Zones / Abnormal Course Conditions (Rule 2.4)

Players may proceed with free relief (Rule 16.1)

- All flower beds
- Mulched areas
- French drains
- Deep wheel ruts
- Areas defined by White lines
- Road shoulders on holes 6 & 8
- The hill directly below the clubhouse
- Fence behind 9, parking lot, golf shop and centennial plaza

Your Handicap committee wants to remind you that all 9 hole and 18 hole scores must be posted for peer review. You must play at least 9 holes for a score to be acceptable for handicap purposes. When indicating the number of holes played, you'll see the normal 9-hole and 18-hole option. In addition, you will now be able to select 10-17. So, if you played between 10 and 17 holes and 9 of those holes correspond to a 9-hole Ratings, then the score is acceptable.
